## GUIDE TO GRADING

The following guide is presented to help you determine the overall quality of a particular timepiece. Bear in mind that this is a guide only, and thus a numerical range is given for each category. A mint watch that shows no wear but is very lightly marred would not be dropped down to excellent because of this minor blemish. The fact remains that the overall condition is still mint. The reverse of this, of course, would be a watch that is graded excellent even though the case shows very little wear. It may show a brassy look and thus the excellent rating. The most important factor is that every watch sold by ASHLAND is fairly priced in relationship to its grade.

## CASES AND MOVEMENTS

- UNUSED — 100% - Never worn, no problems whatsoever, looks the same as it did when it left the jeweler's store. Watches in this condition are seldom seen and command significant premiums.  
MINT 90% — 99% - A seldom used watch showing very minor handling blemishes.  
NEAR MINT — 80% - 89% - Shows evidence of occasional use, no easily noticeable signs of wear. A very presentable watch.  
EXCELLENT — 70% - 79% - Wear and occasional use are evident, but there may be minor brass on gold-filled cases. There may be minor dings or scratches.  
FAIR — 50% - 69% - Daily and frequent use are obvious, easily noticeable brass and wear, and possible dings and scratches.

## DIALS

- SUPERB — No hairlines, scratches, cracks, flakes or chips visible. In metal dials, full original color, no stains, blemishes or scratches.  
VERY FINE — Very attractive but has a light hairline or a couple of edge flakes.  
AVERAGE — A few hairlines or a well repaired flake can be found. In metal dials, some discoloration or other slight problems.  
BELOW AVERAGE — Some damage or other serious problems. In metal dials, discoloration to a point where it should be refinished.

## RARITY GRADE

A select group of watches in this catalog have been assigned a "rarity grade" which will appear in the description heading. The total production number of U.S. made pocket watches and vintage wrist watches are fairly well known and accessible, unlike the large and more varied output of European makers and of early horological examples. Therefore, this simplified 1 thru 10 numerical grade is designed to assist collectors and investors in determining the scarcity of a given timepiece in today's market (#1 is considered common to #10, which is an extremely rare item).

The following factors are the basis of assigned rarity levels:

- Market availability, both past and present.
- Technical quality and innovative design.
- Historical importance.
- Condition in relationship to other examples of similar type.
- Artistic case design, i.e. enamel, unusual shape or form pieces.
- Low survival rate of similar types.
- Investment potential for increase in demand and price.

A rarity grade will be assigned to highlight items which offer strong investment potential (generally items of level 5 thru 10).

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**#1. SWISS FABULOUS NEW/OLD STOCK ART DECO PENDANT WATCH**

*48 x 20mm Sterling-Rhinestones OF SS C. 1920s*

This beautiful Art Deco design forms a wonderful mint case studded with beautiful dazzling rhinestones set in sterling silver. The case is presented with a swivel and a fancy Deco pin. The dial is very fine, white with Arabic hour chapters and Breguet numerals. A 15 jewel Swiss manual wind movement completes this interesting like-new Deco collectible. ....\$575.00

**#2. SWISS ENAMEL & DIAMOND PENDANT WATCH WITH PIN**

*28mm 18K OF PS C. 1900 R-2*

Ten ruby jewels are featured on this gilt cylinder movement. The near mint case is decorated with rose-cut diamonds set within a fancy flower vase on the back cover. Raised gold ribbon work and intertwined leaves form an outer border and the background areas are finished with lovely light aqua-blue enameling. This intriguing item is a imitation ladies verge fusee. The near mint case is covered with a green leather material and is also decorated with golden dots. The dial lifts up to reveal a white and pink porcelain finished inner recessed area for concealing small treasures. The back of the dial plate is set with a mirror finished metal disc. The mint condition verge fusee movement is centered by a pierced two-footed delicate balance cock and a silver disc regulator. The movement features a sophisticated side lever escapement. The golden dial is marked with raised Roman chapters and gold minute dots. The dial is very fine with gold spade pointers. The dial is fully signed and in superb condition with Roman chapters, a black minute track and 5-minute numerals. 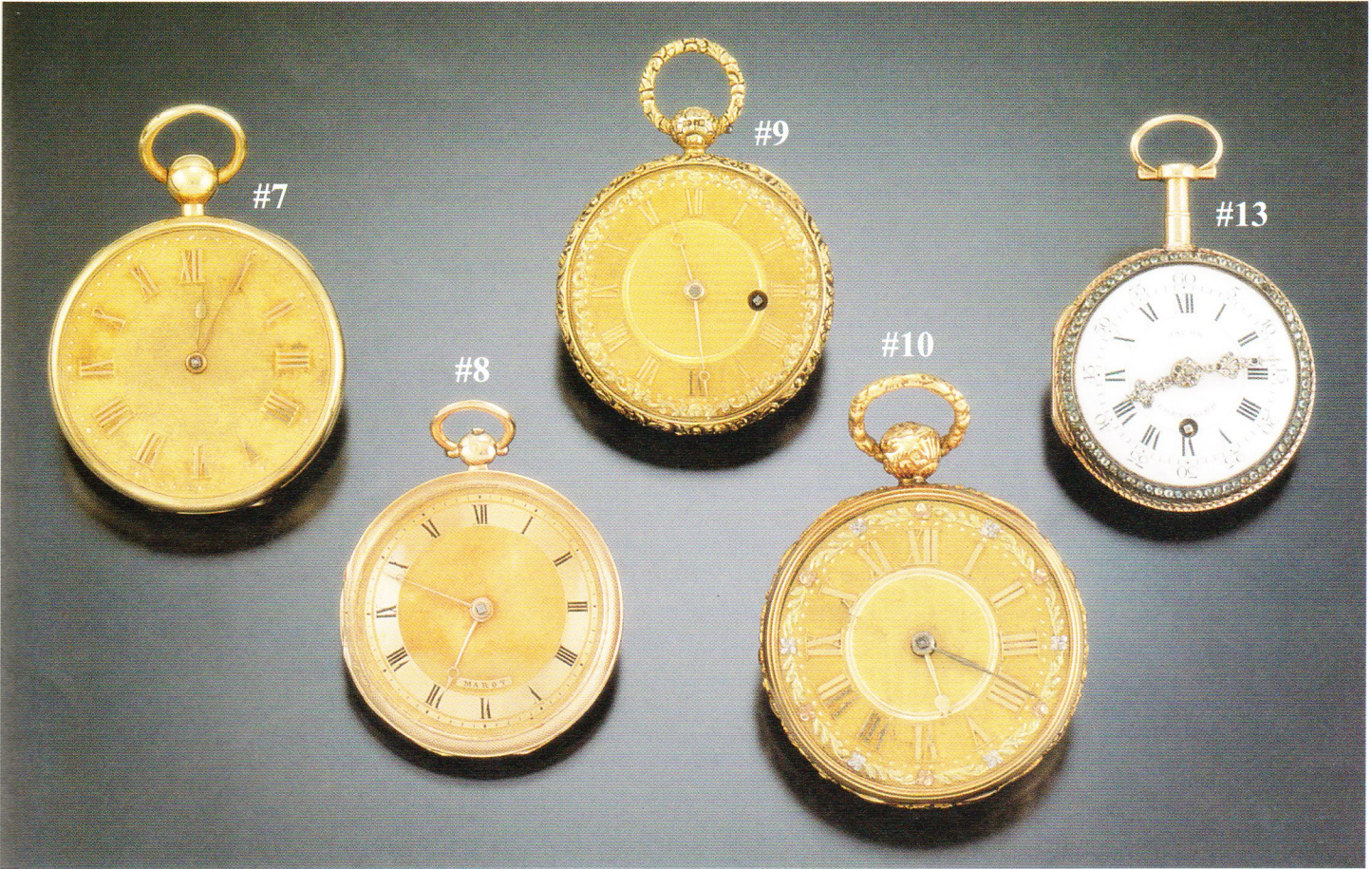

Paste stones form a fancy border on the front bezel of the mint condition case. The back is set with beautiful multi-colored leaf designs and small white flowers ornamented with paste center stones. 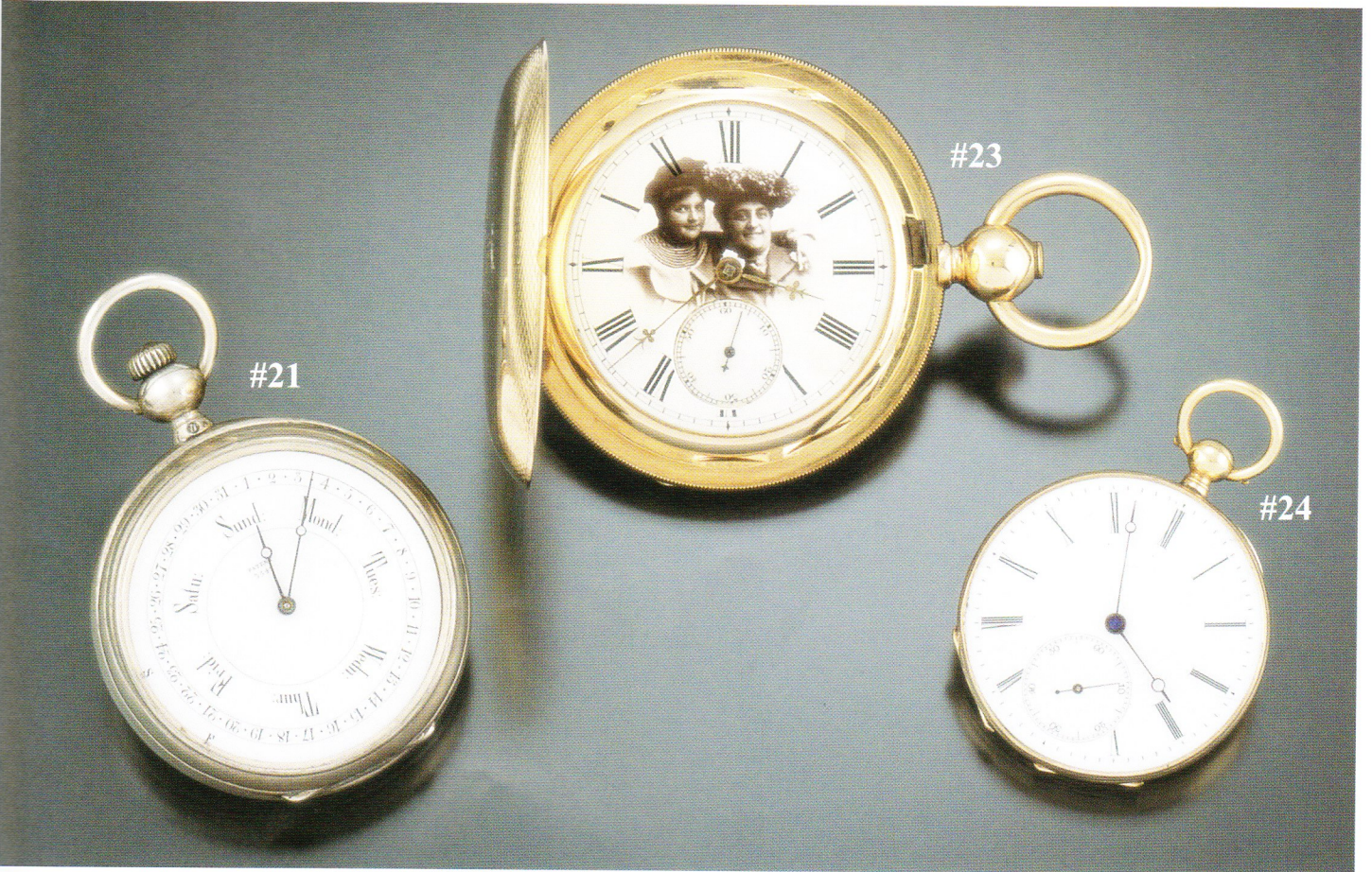

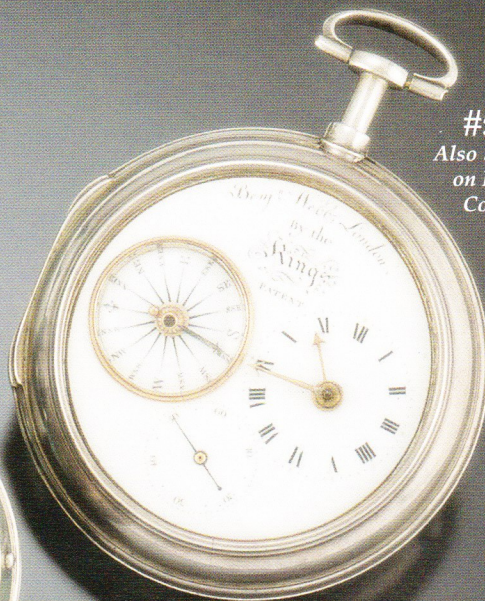
